

Procedures for Accessing Aztec Museum's Newsletter Collection

The Aztec Museum Association has published monthly newsletters since 1980. The newsletters contain articles, descriptions of Museum events, and images of photographs, artifacts and documents. An index to newsletter contents exists for 1980 through 2000.

Public Access

Community members and visitors are welcome to use the newsletters.

The box labeled "Newsletters Index And Circulating Notebooks" may be brought out for any requester to look through. These Circulating Notebooks contain copies of the newsletters which are in good, readable condition. Community members and visitors can read these on site.

If the requestor would like copies of pages, staff may provide up to 12 pages at no cost. More than this may be made, at a charge of 5 cents per page. When an issue is removed from the notebook for copying, place the "file removed" card in its place.
